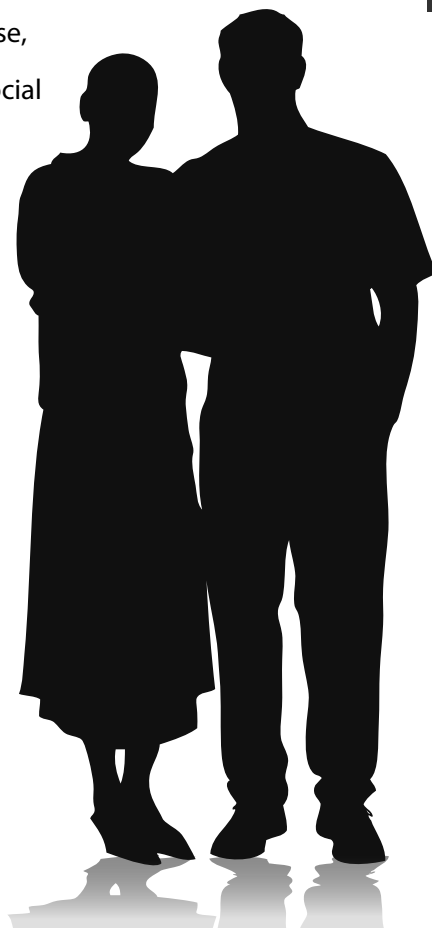
39,185 reports of

services. 50% of APS reports were
substantiated.

APS focuses on:

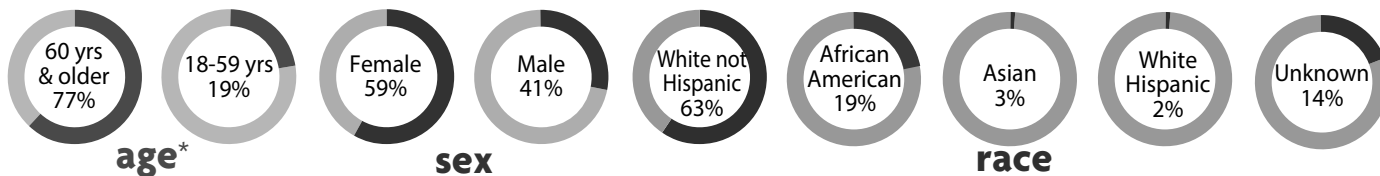
Adults age 60 and over and
