In state fiscal year **2021**

39,185 reports of adult abuse, neglect, and/or exploitation were received by local departments of social services. 50% of APS reports were substantiated.

APS focuses on:

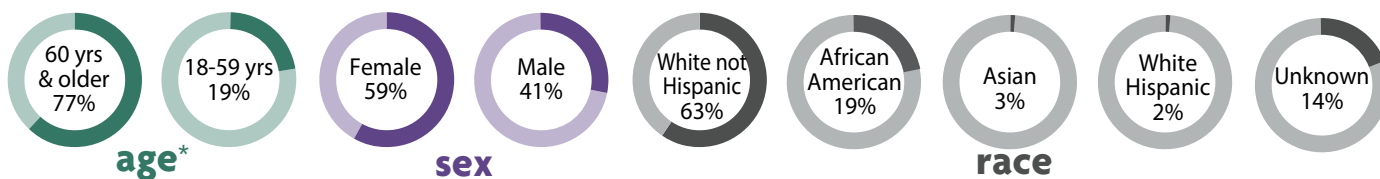
