

Technology Assistance Program (TAP)
Income Eligibility Guidelines
Effective February 2022

To be eligible for the TAP program, your family/household income must be **below** 250% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines, as shown in the following table:

Number of persons in family/household	Annual Income	Monthly Income
1	\$ 33,975	\$ 2,831
2	\$ 45,775	\$ 3,915
3	\$ 57,575	\$ 4,798
4	\$ 69,375	\$ 5,781
5	\$ 81,175	\$ 6,765
6	\$ 92,950	\$ 7,748
7	\$ 104,775	\$ 8,731
8	\$ 116,575	\$ 9,715

For families/households with more than 8 persons, add \$4,720 for each additional person.

- "Income" means the income, total cash receipts before taxes from all sources of the applicant, his dependents, and any person legally required to support the applicant, including a spouse.
- "Family" means the applicant, his dependents and any person legally required to support the applicant, including a spouse.
- Veterans with proof of an Honorable Discharge (form DD214 or substitute) are considered automatically eligible for TAP and do not require review or documentation of income.
